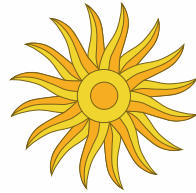

Curriculum Implementation

The teaching and implementation of the Music Curriculum is based on the National Curriculum and is embedded within our termly topics.

Each topic has an enquiry based question and the music curriculum will link in to this in a creative and engaging way.

The progression of knowledge and skills are mapped out on our progression document and further details of the curriculum can be found on the long term planning which spans over two cycles.

Enriching experiences such as Christmas carols, Nativity plays, productions, choir and individual music lessons all add to the wide and varied music curriculum open to all children.

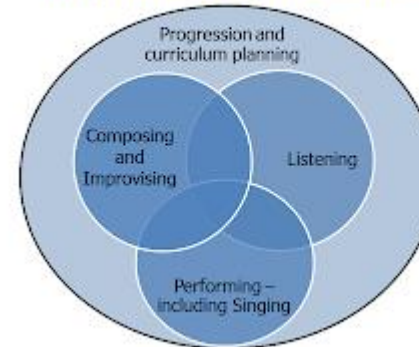
Curriculum Impact

Continuous assessment for learning takes place through observations, pupil conferencing and evaluation of learning.

Teachers use these formative assessments to inform future lessons; ensuring children are supported and challenged appropriately.

Assessments are made against the age related expectations for their year group. These are recorded and reported at the end of each academic year.
