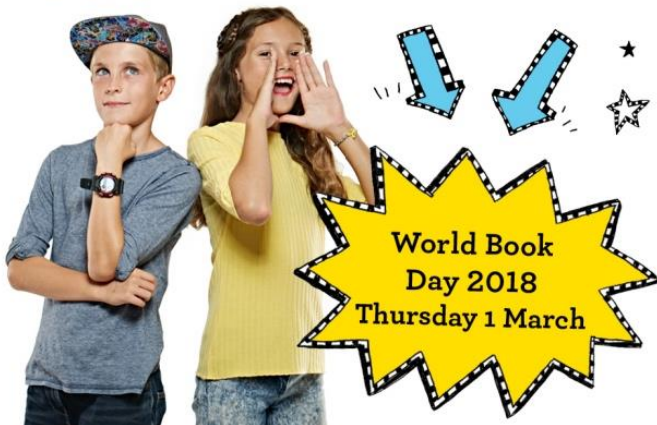
Five ways to Love, Cherish, and Value Yourself

A huge thank you to Mr Buckley and Mr Townsend for their exciting chip cone rocket launch activity with year five children.





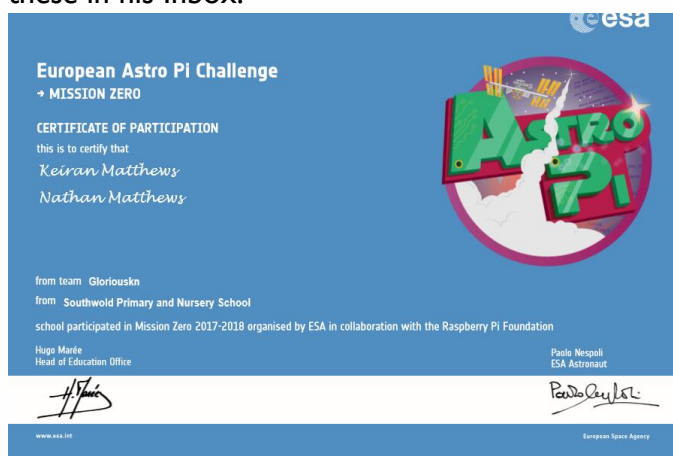

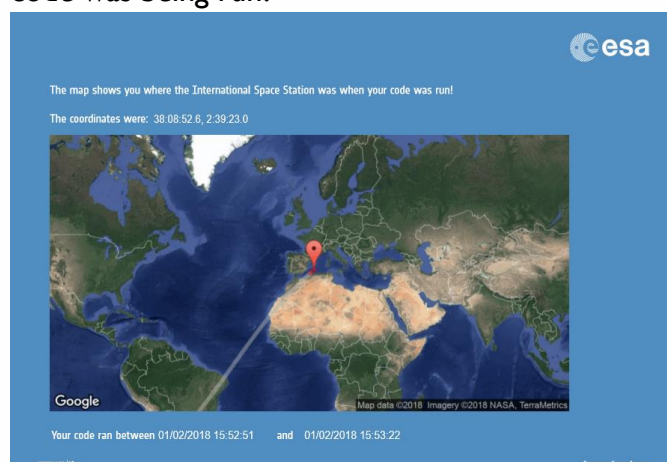
