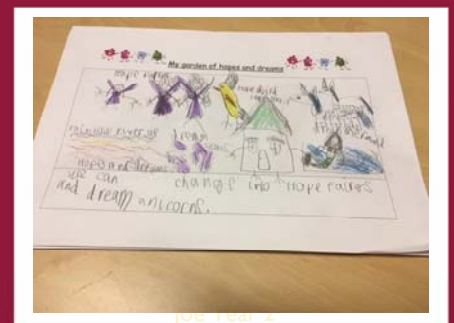
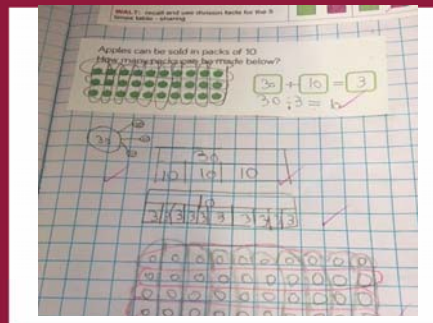
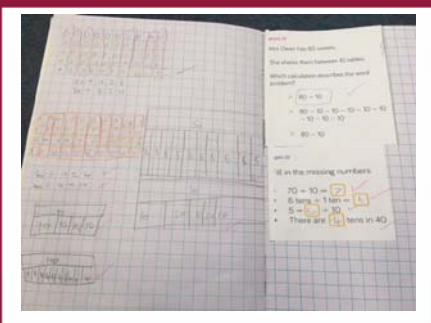


Things to think about as a family...
